PROJECT AGREEMENT FOR PEST ANIMAL AND WEED MANAGEMENT IN DROUGHT-AFFECTED AREAS

PART 1 - PROJECTS

- C1 The Commonwealth will contribute to South Australia's Aiding drought recovery in South Australia through strengthened regional pest control, which will help manage pest animals and weeds in drought-affected areas.
- C2 Activities will include:
 - i. upgrading priority sections of the Dog Fence;
 - ii. enhanced wild dog bait supply to land managers in priority areas;
 - iii. wild dog trapping services in priority areas for landholders who are engaged in strategic wild dog control programs;
- C₃ Funding will be targeted to drought-affected areas experiencing or at risk of wild dog incursions.

PART 2 - PROJECT MILESTONES, REPORTING AND PAYMENTS
