PROJECT AGREEMENT FOR PEST ANIMAL AND WEED MANAGEMENT IN DROUGHT-AFFECTED AREAS

PART 1 - PROJECTS

- A1 The Commonwealth will contribute to Queensland's Feral Pest Initiative, which will help manage pest animals and weeds in drought-affected areas.
- A2 Activities will include:
 - i. cluster exclusion fencing;
 - ii. programmes to control pest animals including wild dogs; and
 - iii. weed control programmes.
- A3 Funding will be targeted to areas Queensland considers to be most in need (i.e. long-term drought-affected areas). Local government areas that were drought declared as of 1 July 2016.

PART 2 - PROJECT MILESTONES, REPORTING AND PAYMENTS

A4 Table 1 summarises the milestone for the project, its relationship to the outputs and expected payment to be made once a report demonstrating that the milestone has been met is received.
