PROJECT AGREEMENT – REVITALISING TAFE CAMPUSES ACROSS AUSTRALIA

vi. To deliver the outputs of this Agreement, the following project(s) will be delivered by Western Australia:

(a) **Project 1 – Expanded trades, specialist and technology infrastructure.** This project includes four sub-projects to improve the quality of VET delivery for industries in WA – rail, agriculture, care and technology.

1. *Specialist rail trade training centre at the Midland Metropolitan Campus*, to support construction and ongoing operations of the WA public and private rail networks;
2. *Agricultural Machinery Trade Workshop Expansion at the Moora Regional Campus*, to provide additional specialist training facilities such as welding bays and support for further apprentices and shorter term training programs and traineeships;
3. *NDIS in-home care simulated training spaces at the Mt Lawley Metropolitan Campus*, to expand training facilities to include two simulated in-home care training spaces;
4. *Technology Enabled Training*, for the purchase of Augmented Simulated Welders; and classroom refurbishment(s) and industry training equipment.
