National Partnership Agreement on Adult Public Dental Services

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ON FEDERAL FINANCIAL RELATIONS

PRELIMINARIES

1. This National Partnership agreement (the Agreement) is created subject to the provisions of the Intergovernmental Agreement on Federal Financial Relations (IGA FFR) and should be read in conjunction with that Agreement and its Schedules, which provide information in relation to performance reporting and payment arrangements under the IGA FFR.
2. In entering this Agreement, the Commonwealth and the States and Territories recognise that they have a mutual interest in improving outcomes in public dental services and need to work together to achieve those outcomes.
3. This Agreement will contribute to the improved oral health of eligible adult public dental patients.
4. The Commonwealth will provide up to \$155 million to the States and Territories to assist them in reducing pressure on the public dental system by providing treatment for 177,778 adult patients of public dental services.

PART 1 – FORMALITIES

Parties to this Agreement

5. This Agreement is between the Commonwealth of Australia (the Commonwealth) and the States and Territories (the States).

Term of the Agreement

6. This Agreement will commence as soon as the Commonwealth and one other Party sign the Agreement and will expire on 30 June 2016 or on completion of the project, including final performance reporting¹ and processing of final payments against performance benchmarks. The Agreement may be terminated earlier or extended as agreed in writing by the Parties.

PART 2 – OBJECTIVES, OUTCOMES AND OUTPUTS

Objectives

7. The Parties aspire to reduce pressure on adult public dental waiting lists.

Outcomes

8. This Agreement will facilitate achievement of the following outcomes:
 - (a) improving the oral health of adult patients who are eligible for public dental services; and
 - (b) reducing waiting times for adult public dental patients.

Outputs

9. The objectives and outcomes of this Agreement will be achieved by providing treatment to an additional 177,778 adult public dental patients.

PART 3 – ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH PARTY

10. To realise the objectives and commitments in this Agreement, each Party has specific roles and responsibilities, as outlined below.

Role of the Commonwealth

11. The Commonwealth agrees to be accountable for the following roles and responsibilities:
 - (a) providing a financial contribution to the States to support the implementation of this Agreement; and
 - (b) monitoring and assessing the performance in the delivery of services under this Agreement to ensure that outputs are delivered and outcomes are achieved within the agreed timeframe.

Role of the States and Territories

12. The States agree to be accountable for the following roles and responsibilities:
 - (a) providing data to the Commonwealth for the purposes of agreeing the 2013-14 baseline;
 - (b) monitoring and assessing the performance in the delivery of services under this Agreement;
 - (c) delivering on outcomes and outputs assigned to the States for implementation; and
 - (d) reporting on the delivery of outcomes and outputs as set out in Part 4 – Performance Monitoring and Reporting.

Shared roles and responsibilities

13. The Commonwealth and the States share the following roles and responsibilities:
 - (a) agreeing the 2013-14 baseline;
 - (b) participating in consultations as appropriate regarding the implementation of this Agreement; and
 - (c) negotiating new or revised Schedules, including Project Plans, to this Agreement.
14. The Parties will meet the requirements of Schedule E, Clause 26 of the Intergovernmental Agreement on Federal Financial Relations, by ensuring that prior agreement is reached on the nature and content of any events, announcements, promotional material or publicity relating to

activities under this Agreement, and that the roles of both Parties will be acknowledged and recognised appropriately.

Project Plans

15. The Commonwealth and the States will agree Project Plans to provide the public with an indication of how the project is intended to be delivered and demonstrate each State's capacity to achieve the outcomes and outputs of the Agreement. Project Plans will:
 - (a) be agreed for each State within one month of both Parties signing this Agreement;
 - (b) set out each State's 2013-14 adult baseline, which for the purposes of this Agreement will include State-funded activity only;
 - (c) describe the activities each State will undertake to increase the number of adult public dental services in the period between 1 July 2015 and 30 June 2016, including where and how additional services will be delivered, in accordance with Schedule A to this Agreement; and
 - (d) be published online.
16. Variations to Project Plans that impact on a State's ability to meet the outcomes and objectives of this Agreement or directly affect milestones and their achievement are subject to written agreement between the relevant Commonwealth and State Ministers.

PART 4 – PERFORMANCE MONITORING AND REPORTING

Performance indicators

17. Achievement of the objectives and outcomes in this Agreement will be informed with reference to the following performance indicators, reported in the format provided in Schedule B:
 - (a) number of adult patients receiving dental services;
 - (b) number of adult patients on dental waiting lists;
 - (c) waiting time for adult patients on public dental waiting lists;
 - (d) number of adults receiving specialist or general anaesthetic services;
 - (e) number of adult dental occasions of service provided; and
 - (f) number of adult additional Dental Weighted Activity Units as defined in clauses 18 to 19 of this Agreement.

Dental Weighted Activity Units²

18. Throughput under this Agreement will be measured in terms of dental weighted activity units (DWAUs), calculated using the Australian Dental Association (ADA) three digit item codes and a weighting for those items as set out in Schedule B³.
19. Nothing in this Agreement prevents a State using its own reporting or performance measures within its jurisdiction. However, States will still be required to report to the Commonwealth in the format provided in Schedule B-2.

Performance benchmarks or milestones

20. The Parties agree to meet the following performance benchmarks, which will be assessed relative to the 2013-14 baseline as defined in clause 15(b):
 - (a) the States will at least maintain their baseline levels of DWAU; and
 - (b) over the life of the Agreement, the States will provide the additional numbers of DWAU set out in Table 1.
21. Payments will not be made unless the State has achieved at least 65 per cent of the performance benchmark for that period. At and above that threshold, payments will be paid proportional to the achievement against the performance benchmark on a pro rata basis, from 65 per cent to 100 per cent of funding (for achieving 100 per cent of the throughput target). If a performance benchmark is not fully met, the amount of any unmet performance benchmark and the remaining available funding tied to the unmet benchmark may be added to the following period, subject to Commonwealth Budget Rules.

² One Dental Weighted Activity Unit is roughly equivalent to completed treatment for one adult patient.

22. Performance relative to the benchmark will be

(a) counted from 1 July 2015; and

(b) calculated by subtracting from the actual performance in the relevant period, a measure of baseline activity, as set out in Table 2. See Schedule B for calculation of baseline activity measures.

23. Estimated performance for the 1 May to 30 June 2016 period will be assessed for consistency with actual performance for the 1 July 2015 to 30 April 2016 period before the payment for the 1 January to 30 June 2016 period is authorised in accordance with clauses 32 or 34 of this Agreement.

Reporting arrangements

24. The States will report on Project Plans at Schedule A and against the agreed performance indicators and benchmarks as set out in Schedule B. Progress reports including throughput data in the format in Schedule B-2 will be provided by the States as set out in Table 2.

PART 5 – FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Financial contributions

25. The Commonwealth will provide a total financial contribution to the States of \$155.0 million in respect of this Agreement.
26. The Commonwealth's funding contribution will not be reduced where the States secure funding from other activity partners through innovative and collaborative partnerships.
27. The Commonwealth's and the States' estimated financial contribution to the operation of this Agreement, including through National Partnership payments to the States paid in accordance with *Schedule D – Payment Arrangements* of the IGA FFR, are shown in Table 3.

(a) States are not required to provide a financial or in-kind contribution under the terms of this Agreement. However, as States are responsible for the provision of public dental services, they allocate their own source funding and provide in-kind contributions accordingly, including in support of services funded under this Agreement.

Project management risk

28. Having regard to the agreed estimated costs of projects specified in this Agreement, a State will not be required to pay a refund to the Commonwealth if the actual cost of the project is less than the agreed estimated cost of the project. Similarly, the States bear all risk should the costs of a project exceed the agreed estimated costs. The Parties acknowledge that this arrangement provides the maximum incentive for the States to deliver projects cost effectively and efficiently.

PART 6 – GOVERNANCE ARRANGEMENTS

Enforceability of the Agreement

29. The Parties do not intend any of the provisions of this Agreement to be legally enforceable. However, that does not lessen the Parties' commitment to this Agreement.

Variation of the Agreement

30. The Agreement may be amended at any time by agreement in writing by all the Parties.
31. A Party to the Agreement may terminate their participation in the Agreement at any time by notifying all the other Parties in writing.

Delegations

32. The relevant Commonwealth Minister with portfolio responsibility for health is authorised to agree and amend Schedules, including Project Plans, to this Agreement and to certify that performance benchmarks specified under this Agreement have been achieved, so that payments may be made.
33. Respective State Ministers with portfolio responsibility for health are authorised to agree and amend Schedules, including Project Plans, to this Agreement.
34. The Commonwealth Minister may delegate the assessment of project-based performance benchmarks and the authorisation of related project payments to senior Commonwealth officials, having regard to the financial and policy risks associated with those payments.
35. The Commonwealth and State Ministers with portfolio responsibility for health may delegate to senior Commonwealth and State officials the assessment and authorisation of administrative amendments to the Schedules, including Project Plans, where these changes will not impact on a State's ability to meet the outcomes and objectives of this Agreement.

Dispute resolution

36. Any Party may give notice to other Parties of a dispute under this Agreement.
37. Officials of relevant Parties will attempt to resolve any dispute in the first instance.
38. If a dispute cannot be resolved by officials, it may be escalated to the relevant Ministers.

Definitions

NATIONAL PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT ON ADULT PUBLIC DENTAL SERVICES

A) Number of patients receiving dental services:

Adults: total count of people as per METeOR identifiers "Person Identifier" (287172) and "Age"(303794) - 18 years and older.

B) Number of patients on dental waiting lists:

General: total count of people using codes 1 and 2 from METeOR identifier "Public dental waiting list episode - waiting list type" (429615).

Specialist: total count of people for those services defined as 'specialist' as per the state or territory's own definition. Usually a referred list.

Adults as per (A) above.

C) Average waiting time for patients on / removed from public dental waiting lists:

"Average waiting time": state or territory to use their own internal definition.

General: count of people using codes 1 and 2 from METeOR identifier "Public dental waiting list episode - waiting list type" (429615).

Specialist: average waiting time for those services defined as 'specialist' as per state or territory's own definition. Usually a referred list.

Adults as per (A) above.

D) Specialist and general anaesthetic (GA) services:

GA: count of people provided a service under ADA Item 949 or CW01.

Specialist: count of people provided a service by a specialist dental practitioner as defined by APRHA (<http://www.ahpra.gov.au/Registration/Registers-of-Practitioners/Specialties-and-Specialty-Fields.aspx>)

Adults as per (A) above.

E) Number of dental occasions of services provided:

"Occasions of Service" (Visit): a public dental visit is defined as an appointment with a dental professional. The appointment can be for assessment or treatment purposes.
