

DEED OF VARIATION No. 1

Between the

COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA ('the Commonwealth'), as represented by the Department of Health and Ageing ('the Department') ABN 83 605 426 759

And

THE STATE OF VICTORIA ('the State'), as represented by the Department of Health ABN 74 410 330 756

RECITALS:

- A. The parties agreed to vary the agreement relating to the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program dated 28 April 2009 ('the Principal Agreement').
- B. Clause 1.6 of the Principal Agreement states that no variation is binding unless it is agreed in writing between the parties.
- C. This Deed of Variation confirms the variations to the Principal Agreement agreed by the parties.
- D. The parties acknowledge and agree that:
 - (a) the Principal Agreement was originally entered into by the State of Victoria as represented by the Department of Human Services;
 - (b) due to a change in the machinery of government in Victoria, responsibility for the Principal Agreement has transferred from the Department of Human Services to the Department of Health; and
 - (c) references in the Principal Agreement to the Department of Human Services are taken to be references to the Department of Health.

OPERATIVE PART:

- 1. The parties vary the Principal Agreement as follows with effect on and from 30 June 2011:
- 1.1 In Item A of the Schedule in the last dot point, delete '30 June 2011' and replace with '30 June 2012';
- 1.2 In Item B of the Schedule in the first sentence, delete '30 June 2011' and replace with '30 June 2012';

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- 1.3 In the table in Item B of the Schedule, delete '30 June 2011' and replace with '30 June 2012'
- 1.4 Delete Item D of the Schedule and replace with the following:

'D. FUNDS (clauses 1.1, 2 and 3)

The maximum amount of Funds to be paid by the Commonwealth to the State is \$1,775,592 (GST exclusive).

The due date for payment is 30 days after receipt of a correctly rendered invoice by the Commonwealth.

A correctly rendered invoice is one that:

- (a) identifies the name of the Project;
- (b) sets out the name of the Commonwealth Liaison Officer;
- (c) contains a claim for the amount of funds properly required; and
