Dear Minister

Thank you for your correspondence of 6 August 2021 seeking my agreement to amend the due dates for milestones 6 and 7 under Schedule C of the *Project Agreement for Delivering Environmental Measures in the Northern Murray–Darling Basin* for the Fencing Northern Basin Riverbanks Program.

I note your advice that delivery against these milestones has been delayed due to an unanticipated complexity in initial stakeholder negotiations, which officers at the Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment advise me are now satisfactorily resolved. I am also satisfied, based on their advice, that the program implementation approach has been improved in Queensland to deliver on the program's intended outcomes.

I agree to your proposal to extend the delivery dates for milestones 6 and 7 to 31 August 2021 and 30 November 2021 respectively. I do so on the understanding that remaining milestones under Schedule C will be delivered as per the existing dates, that this delay in progress is temporary and its causes have been addressed.

To formalise this adjustment, I enclose a revised copy of Table 1 under Schedule C to the *Project Agreement for Delivery of Environmental Measures in Northern Murray–Darling Basin.* This will now replace the original Table 1 in the schedule.

I look forward to receiving the milestone 6 and 7 reports in the coming months.
