Purpose	<p>This Schedule will support local councils to deliver new or renewed infrastructure directly related to recreational fishing, boating and camping, including but not limited to: projects that improve access to recreational fishing, boating or camping areas and, improved infrastructure and facilities at recreational fishing, boating and camping areas or marine rescue.</p> <p>The output of this Agreement will be the delivery by local councils and the Australian Capital Territory Government to construct or improve infrastructure related to recreational fishing, boating and camping facilities, including but not limited to construction or improvement of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. boat ramps;</li> <li>b. marine rescue facilities;</li> <li>c. toilet blocks;</li> <li>d. fish cleaning stations;</li> <li>e. camping facilities; or</li> <li>f. other infrastructure or facilities directly associated with recreational fishing, boating or camping.</li> </ol>




