Duration	This Schedule will commence as soon as it is signed by the Parties. It is expected to expire on 30 June 2025 or upon completion of the projects.
Purpose	<p>The Fighting Cancer – Regional Cancer Treatment Centres for Radiation Therapy program is designed to expand cancer treatment capacity throughout regional Australia by enhancing existing and investing in new health infrastructure.</p> <p>This Schedule will support the establishment of a radiation oncology consult outreach service in the East Gippsland region by enhancing existing and investing in infrastructure in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Central Gippsland Health Service (Sale); and • Bairnsdale Regional Health Service <p>The Activity will establish a radiation oncology consult outreach service supplemented by telehealth consults and a local skin radiotherapy treatment service, all supported by more modern medical imaging to service the population of the East Gippsland region.</p> <p>The project includes construction of four purpose-built consult rooms that incorporate telehealth facilities, a superficial X-ray radiotherapy (SXRT) treatment facility and the installation of a high-quality computed tomography (CT) scanner at the Central Gippsland Health Service, and a diagnostic CT scanner two consult rooms with telehealth capability at Bairnsdale Regional Health Service.</p> <p>This will enable patients diagnosed with cancer living in far East Gippsland to receive radiation oncology consults via the radiotherapy outreach at Central Gippsland Health Service.</p>
Estimated financial contributions	The Commonwealth will provide an estimated total financial contribution to the Victorian State Government of \$4.450 million in respect of this Schedule.

Victoria will provide an estimated in-kind contribution to this project of \$830,000.


