## Schedule B – Northern Territory

#### PART 1: PRELIMINARIES

- This schedule has been developed in accordance with clause 13 of the Project Agreement for Comprehensive Palliative Care in Aged Care and should be read in conjunction with that Agreement.
- 2. This schedule will commence as soon as it is agreed between the Commonwealth and the Northern Territory and expires on 30 June 2024 or on completion of the project whichever is earlier, including final performance reporting and processing of final payments against milestones.

#### PART 2: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

3. The Commonwealth and the Northern Territory estimated financial contribution to the operation of this Schedule are shown below.

- 7. Northern Territory will also prepare an annual report due 30 April 2021, 30 April 2022, 30 April 2023 and 30 April 2024, that includes:
  - a. Commence implementation of the NT Comprehensive Palliative Care in Aged Care model in the Old Timers Nursing Home incorporating Flynn Lodge and Hetti Perkins Nursing Home:
    - i. Commence screening of residents using Palliative Care Needs rounds model
    - ii. Support RACF's and attendant GP's to develop a plan for End Of Life preferences utilizing Advance Personal Plans, Goals of Care plans etc. for all patients screened
    - iii. Deliver, monitor and evaluate a cycle of routine educational activities including case based reviews in RACF's
    - iv. Targeted case reviews with GP's
    - v. Monitor Alice Springs Hospital Emergency Department admissions from all Central Australia RACF's and conduct case reviews to identify if the admission was preventable.
