Immediate Assistance Fund Project to Develop Citrus Canker Specific Scent Lures

PART 1: PRELIMINARIES

- 1. The purpose of this Schedule is to outline the delivery of agreed activities of the Project to Develop Citrus Canker (*Xanthomonas citri* subsp. *citri*) Specific Scent Lures (the project) to facilitate the use of detector dogs for response activities in the Northern Territory.
- 2. The project is being conducted under the Immediate Assistance Fund (IAF) guidelines.
- 3. If required, this Schedule will be reviewed relative to the project milestones and in accordance with the evaluation mechanisms of the IAF.

PART 2: FORMALITIES

- 4. The Parties to this Schedule are the Commonwealth of Australia and the Northern Territory (the jurisdiction).

 - (a) Engage a laboratory to identify a volatile profile of citrus canker.
 - (b) Develop a citrus canker scent lure.
 - (c) Optimise methods to develop baits from citrus canker infected plant material
 - (d) Obtain a trained detector dog for dual imprint using the lure developed in item (b).
- 7. To qualify for the associated payment, the jurisdiction must meet the following milestones:
