- The Department agrees to provide reasonable notice to the Recipient of any upcoming relevant Department prepared media releases, media engagements or anticipated media coverage relevant to the Program.

# 4. Freedom of Information

The Northern Territory must provide the Department notice of any Freedom of Information (FOI) requests in relation to the Program.

# 5. Ad Hoc

5.1 The Northern Territory agrees to provide additional reports, data or information in relation to the progress or specific activities of the Program where reasonably requested by the Department for reporting purposes, such as Senate Estimates.

### 6. Evaluation

6.1 The Northern Territory agrees to participate in any evaluations of the Program as commissioned by the Department.
