States are required to report to the Commonwealth in the format provided in Schedule B2. States are permitted to use their own reporting or performance measures within their jurisdiction.

On signing, the States will provide the Commonwealth with a description of how waiting lists are defined in their jurisdiction and will commit to working towards a nationally agreed definition of waiting times.

## **Performance Benchmarks or Milestones**

Performance activity is measured from 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023.

The Parties agree to meet the following performance benchmarks, which will be assessed relative to the 2013-14 baseline:

- (a) the States will at least maintain their baseline levels of DWAU, as identified as the 2013-14 baseline (Schedule B3 revised 2022); and
- (b) over the life of the Schedule, the States will provide the additional DWAU as set out in Table 2 below.

Payments will be paid proportional to the achievement against the performance benchmarks outlined in Table 2, on a pro rata basis, i.e. 100 per cent of funding for achieving 100 per cent of the Target DWAU above the baseline.

If a performance benchmark is not fully met, the unmet performance benchmark and the remaining available funding tied to the unmet benchmark may be added to a subsequent period, subject to Commonwealth Budget Rules.

## Rollover

DWAUs achieved above 100% of the required activity under the 2021-22 Federation Funding Agreement for Public Dental Services for Adults are eligible under this Schedule.

## **Catch-up Provisions**

DWAUs delivered during the 2021-22 catch-up period (1 April 2022 to 30 June 2022) in order to achieve 100% of the performance target under the 2021-22 Federation Funding Agreement for Public Dental Services for Adults are ineligible under this Schedule.

States may count DWAUs delivered between 1 April 2023 - 30 June 2023 (catch-up period) toward their 2022-23 performance target.

<b>Dispute Resolution</b> Officials of relevant Parties can agree to amend Target DWAU, Baseline
DWAU and 2021-22 rolled-over DWAUs in a performance milestone where they might be incorrect.
