Purpose	<p>This Schedule will support activities to establish a new integrated data asset and to undertake research related to Social Impact Investment initiatives.</p> <p>The new integrated data asset is will be created from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Australian Bureau of Statistics Multi-Agency Data Integration Project (MADIP), and • The Better Evidence Better Outcomes Linked Data (BEBOLD) platform developed by the University of Adelaide in partnership with SA/NT DataLink and the South Australian Government. <p>The objectives of the research are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>Evidence for what works</u>: Investigate the impact of policies, and participation in programs (including the South Australian Social Impact Investment initiatives of Resilient Families, Newpin and Aspire), on relevant outcomes in health, wellbeing, justice, education, social and welfare domains. 2. <u>Program eligibility</u>: Investigate potentially eligible populations for specific supportive programs or investments, this will include understanding the 'reach' of specific proposed or existing government initiatives, i.e. what proportion of eligible populations are reached by such programs? 3. <u>Client characteristics</u>: Develop a greater understanding of client population profiles and service contact patterns, including client crossovers among state and commonwealth funded health, education, justice, social and welfare services.

	<p>4. <u>Precursors and consequences of system contact</u>: Investigate the precursors of, and consequences of, system contact such as child protection, justice, welfare, hospital and community health, mental health, drug and alcohol, education, housing, family support.</p>

BetterStart will provide approval for use of BEBOLD content on a project-by-project basis whilst MADIP approvals will be managed by the existing MADIP project proposal process facilitated by the ABS.</p>
