

Parties	Commonwealth Australian Capital Territory (ACT)																							
Duration	This Schedule is expected to expire on 30 June 2025 or on completion of projects, including final evaluation reports, unless terminated earlier or extended as agreed in writing by the Parties.																							
Purpose	This Schedule will support the deployment of shared solar infrastructure on multi-unit developments targeting 460 - 2,100 households in the ACT to lower household energy costs. The final number of households will depend on the number of applications and the cost per household.
