	This Schedule will support the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) in delivering its Shared Reduction Amount (SRA) of 4.9 gigalitres per year (GL/y) Long Term Diversion Limit Equivalence (LTDLE) to meet the Sustainable Diversion Limit (SDL) under the Murray—Darling Basin Plan (The Project).					
	As a result of this project, a 6.36 GL/y entitlement will become Commonwealth environmental water holdings that will be 'held' by the Commonwealth Environmental Water Holder (CEWH) in accordance with the <i>Water Act 2007</i> .					
	Of the 6.36 GL/y, 4.9 GL/y will fulfill the ACT's SDL resource unit SRA targe set out in the <i>Basin Plan 2012</i> .					
	Under the <i>Water Act 2007</i> and <i>Basin Plan 2012</i> , the Commonwealth Minister may allocate the additional 1.46 GL/y to become an additional held environmental water entitlement if it satisfies the specified criteria.
