Duration	This Schedule is expected to expire on 30 June 2025.
Purpose	This Schedule supports states and territories to expand existing direct access colonoscopy triage models for participants of the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program (NBCSP) that return a positive bowel cancer screening result, and improve access to and reporting of public diagnostic colonoscopy services. Activities under this Schedule will include (but are not limited to) the identification and implementation of improvements to: • streamline and expand referral pathways to improve equitable and timely access to colonoscopy for NBCSP participants referred to the public system for diagnostic investigation, particularly those located in remote and rural locations; • public hospital colonoscopy reporting to the National Cancer Screening Register, consistent with Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care, 'Colonoscopy Clinical Care Standard, Quality Statement 9-Reporting and follow-up', to ensure accurate and timely reporting against the performance indicators for the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program; and • the assessment of activities undertaken under this Schedule and the outcomes achieved under this agreement. Note: The Commonwealth is separately partnering with states and territories to support the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program Participant Follow Up Function (PFUF), which aims to encourage Program participants along the screening pathway following a positive faecal occult blood test, through the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program – Participant Follow-up Function (PFUF) Schedule.

Estimated financial contributions

The Commonwealth will provide an estimated total financial contribution to the States of \$10.165 million in respect of this Schedule.
