Purpose	This Schedule will support the delivery of the Far North Queensland (FNQ) Connect initiative to explore a model of integrating care and support services, strengthen local community workforces, and build inclusive communities across FNQ.			
	The FNQ Connect initiative aims to increase successful NDIS plan utilisation, workforce capability and efficient integration of resources for the people of FNQ.			
	Funding under the Schedule will support Stage 1 (years 1 and 2) of FNO Connect with a final report including a business case for funding Stage 2 in years 3, 4, and 5 to be developed as part of project deliverables in year 2.			
	The FNQ Connect initiative complements the Commonwealth's recent commitment to develop and pilot alternative approaches to the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) service commissioning in critically thin markets in partnership with First Nations representatives and remote communities.			
Strategic Alignment	This Schedule is framed to align with all four Priority Reform areas and socio-economic Outcome 9 (Targets 9A and 9B), Outcome 13, and Outcome 14 set out in the National Agreement on Closing the Gap. In entering into this Schedule, the Commonwealth and Queensland Government recognise their mutual commitment to improve outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, and the need to work together to achieve those outcomes.			
Outputs	The outputs of this Agreement will be the implementation and evaluation of the FNQ Connect initiative and the three priority streams of projects outlined in the FNQ Connect project proposal (attached) and the final Business Case for Stage 2 (years 3, 4 and 5) based on the economic evaluation and detailed needs assessment.			
	These outputs will be confirmed under the Workplan between the Queensland Government and FNQ Connect which will include the

Estimated financial contributions

The Commonwealth will provide an estimated total financial contribution to the Queensland Government of up \$4,550,000.00 (GST exclusive) in respect of this Schedule.

The Queensland Government will co-contribute in-kind departmental resourcing to oversee administration and management components of FNQ Connect initiative, including the grant and contract management arrangements with James Cook University (JCU), project governance, contract management activities, and monitoring project deliverables and reporting in line with performance benchmarks, milestones and regular contract reporting to the Queensland Government.
