## Additional terms

- 1. First Nations participation targets
- 1.1 The Queensland Government will be responsible for working to meet Indigenous economic participation objectives in the SEQ City Deal including a minimum target of 3 per cent Aboriginal employment, and a minimum of 3 per cent of contract value for Indigenous businesses and suppliers.
- 2. Business cases and Project Plans
- 2.1 Business cases and Project Plans will need to provide as a minimum the details of:
  - (a) project management arrangements, including an implementation schedule for the delivery of the project and costs associated with each element of the schedule;
  - (b) risk management for both project delivery and for any potential operational risks;
  - (c) governance arrangements including management of any approvals or regulatory requirements;
  - (d) stakeholder engagement;
  - (e) expected employment opportunities generated as a result of the project;
  - (f) proposals on how the project will meet the City Deal's Indigenous supplier-use target of at least 3 per cent and Indigenous employer target of at least 3 per cent for capital projects; and
  - (g) any other information relevant to enable Commonwealth to consider the business case or project plan.
- 3. Project Funds
- 3.1 Where an output in table 2 has a performance milestone that requires submission and acceptance of a project plan, that performance milestone must be achieved before any further milestones can be claimed.
- 3.2 Further to clause 31 of the FFA Infrastructure:
  - (a) where a decision is made to discontinue or alter a commitment or project, reallocation of remaining surplus funds for that commitment or project can be endorsed by agreement of the Parties to this Schedule.
- 4. Reports
- 4.1 Every six months the Queensland Government will provide the Australian Government with a performance report providing a description of the actual performance in the period against project milestones listed in Table 2.

- 4.2 The Queensland Government will monitor and provide Deal performance reports on:
  - (a) meeting the 3 per cent Aboriginal employment and a minimum of 3 per cent of contract value for Indigenous businesses and suppliers;
  - (b) general employment outcomes; and
  - (c) benefits realised, where applicable.
