Water Infrastructure Projects – New South Wales

NATIONAL PARTNERSHIP FOR THE NATIONAL WATER
INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT FUND - CAPITAL COMPONENT

- A1 This Schedule has been developed in accordance with clause 14 of the National Partnership Agreement on National Water Infrastructure Development Fund Capital Component. It will commence as soon as it is agreed between the Commonwealth and New South Wales, and expire on 30 June 2025 or on completion of the projects, including final reporting and processing of final payments against milestones.
- A2 To deliver the outputs of this Agreement, the following projects will be delivered by New South Wales:
 - (a) Project 1 Wyangala Water Treatment Plant and Dam Wall Raising Detailed Business Case. This project will investigate the merits of increasing the storage capacity of Wyangala Dam by raising the embankment and downstream rock fill to add an additional 65oGL storage capacity to the existing dam to improve water security and drought resilience for the Lachlan Valley. The project will also include construction of a new Wyangala Water Treatment Plant.
 - (b) Project 2 New Dungowan Pipeline Stage 1 and New Dungowan Dam Detailed Business Case. This project will investigate the merits of constructing a new dam at Dungowan, increasing storage capacity from 6.3GL to 22.5GL, to improve water availability and security in the Peel Valley. It also includes construction of a pipeline connecting the new Dungowan Dam to Calala Water Treatment Plant.
- A3 In accordance with clause 15 of the National Partnership Agreement, New South Wales will ensure that prior agreement is reached with the Commonwealth in relation to events, announcements, promotional material or publicity relating to the projects, and that the role of the Commonwealth is acknowledged and recognised appropriately.
- A4 In accordance with clauses 17 and 18 of the National Partnership Agreement, New South Wales will provide project plans and six monthly reports on the progress of each project as well as final project reports.
- A5 The Commonwealth and non-commonwealth contributors will provide an estimated total financial contribution to projects in New South Wales of \$1,134,000,000 in respect of this Agreement as show in Table A2. All payments are GST exclusive.
