Additional terms

New South Wales will confirm the Commonwealth's satisfaction of the terms and conditions within the proposed event sponsorship agreement between New South Wales and Paddle Australia to be executed by the parties with the terms to substantially reflect this agreement between New South Wales and the Commonwealth.

Agreement terms and conditions

Rights and benefits

The Commonwealth will be offered Event rights and benefits equivalent to those received by New South Wales, including but not limited to; ministerial invitations, publicity, marketing and speaking opportunities, and ticketing allocations.

Major sponsors

Major sponsors associated with the Event must align with key Australian values of freedom, respect, fairness and equality of opportunity and may not impede or otherwise prevent the Commonwealth from obtaining the full benefit of the rights and benefits granted in the event sponsorship agreement. The Commonwealth will be provided advanced notice of at least three (3) Business Days of any public announcement of a major sponsor for the Event.

Funding arrangements

Commonwealth funding contributions will be provided on achievement of each agreed project milestone as set out in Table 2 of this Schedule

and subject to the Commonwealth's assessment and agreement on the achievement of each milestone's performance benchmark. For the avoidance of doubt, by providing the milestone contribution, the Commonwealth certifies that it is in agreement with New South Wales that the milestone performance benchmark has been achieved.

Program governance and reporting

The Commonwealth and New South Wales will participate in regular project oversight meetings together with Paddle Australia, for the purpose of monitoring and assessing performance in delivery of the project under this Schedule. In particular, New South Wales will provide relevant information on the development and progress of the Event to the Commonwealth on request and New South Wales will liaise with third-party proponents where required, to assist the Commonwealth with performing its roles and responsibilities.

Evaluation Plan

New South Wales and Paddle Australia will work with the Commonwealth to develop an Evaluation Plan to produce Event Reports that assess the socio-economic impacts of the Event.

The Evaluation Plan must demonstrate how Paddle Australia will evaluate the impact of the Championships. The Evaluation Plan must include details of:

- o the objectives and outcomes being sought by hosting the Event, including:
 - economic impacts, including tourism data;
 - social impacts of hosting the Event, including inclusion, community sentiment and engagement;
 - sustainability impacts; and
 - sport impacts.
- o how the objectives and outcomes will be measured;
- who is responsible for gathering the relevant metrics and indicators;
- when and how the relevant metrics and indicators will be obtained; and
- how legislative and regulatory requirements will be complied with when collecting, using and otherwise handling data.
