Duration	This Schedule is expected to expire on 30 June 2030 or on completion of the initiative if after the end date, including final performance reporting and processing of final payments against milestones.
Purpose	<p>This Schedule will support the establishment of the South Australia Comprehensive Cancer Network (SACCaN), a centralised network of expertise from across South Australia, with linkages to other jurisdictions that will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• improve cancer care and treatment equity for people with poor health outcomes;</li> <li>• maximise cancer prevention and early detection;</li> <li>• improve cancer care and treatment options for consumers;</li> <li>• deliver health systems for optimal cancer care based on the available evidence;</li> <li>• support South Australia's workforce to transform delivery of cancer care; and</li> <li>• build strong and dynamic foundations for South Australia's cancer sector.</li> </ul> <p>SACCaN will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• reduce rural and remote travel to metropolitan locations for cancer care and treatment;</li> <li>• build capacity and infrastructure for future treatment, research and clinical trials;</li> <li>• meet future demand for services and improve health equity across South Australia; and</li> <li>• enhance and improve services for all types of cancer, including complex and rare cancers through the availability and integration of multidisciplinary cancer services.</li> </ul> <p>Key outputs from this Schedule will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• establishment of a SACCaN governance structure;</li> <li>• establishment of a data and intelligence infrastructure including a Clinical Cancer Database/Registry;</li> <li>• design of a comprehensive, integrated cancer data platform including design to support integrated systems;</li> <li>• establishment of a clinical trials hub including tele trial facilities</li> </ul>

	<p>and biomarker informed patent mapping;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Optimal Care Pathway implementation and compliance, including development of standards to monitor and report outcomes aligned to the Optimal Care Pathway indicators;</li> <li>• Cancer Care Navigation Program implementation, including a framework to deliver effective and equitable care navigation across the cancer continuum; and</li> <li>• capital purchases relating to SACCaN objectives including cancer imaging and diagnostic equipment, office accommodation for project teams and data intelligence infrastructure.</li> </ul>

South Australia will ensure that any claim for funding under the NHRA is not funding services, or any part of a service, provided for under this agreement and will maintain appropriate records.</p> <p>The <i>Health Insurance Act 1973</i> prohibits the payment of Medicare benefits where other government funding is provided for that service. South Australia will ensure any agreement for the provision of services using funding under this agreement recognises the operation of the <i>Health Insurance Act 1973</i>.</p>
