Purpose	This Schedule will fund the <i>River Murray in South Australia Constraints</i> <i>Measure Stage 2</i> (the Project). The South Australian (SA) River Murray Constraints Measure will manage the impacts of flows proposed under the constraints measure and include improving access roads and tracks and installing and modifying infrastructure.			
	The Project builds on the preconstruction activities undertaken under the Project Agreement for Stage 1 Funding for Sustainable Diversion Limits Adjustment Supply and Constraints Measures in the Murray- Darling Basin (Schedule C) and incorporates elements of the Early Works component of the Project which commenced in February 2022.			
	The total figure in table 1 includes \$10.832 already provided to South Australia for completed milestones under a previous schedule for the Early Works project. For further detail refer to the River Murray in South Australia Constraints Measure – Early Works Project Schedule.			
	In recognition that Early Works was the accelerated early delivery of Stage 2, this Schedule replaces the River Murray in South Australia Constraints Measure – Early Works Project Schedule and incorporates all Stage 2 activities and budgets encompassing Early Works.			
	The SA River Murray Constraints Measure is part of the Murray-Darling Basin Plan's Sustainable Diversion Limit (SDL) adjustment mechanism, which enables the Plan's SDLs to be increased by 605 gigalitres (GL).			
Total Estimated financial contributions	The Commonwealth will provide a total financial contribution to the State of South Australia of up to \$90.788 million in respect of this Schedule as shown in Table 1. All payments are GST exclusive.

- Project activities for delivery over 6 month reporting periods (2 reporting periods per year) 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 financial years
- Indicative budgets.

Progress Report minimum requirements

- A statement that demonstrates overall progress and updates for each activity against the accepted annual work plan supported by relevant evidence.
- Identify if the outputs are on track and if any outputs are outstanding. In the case of delays, report the reason for the delay and mitigation action.
- Progress update on the On-ground works and construction activities.
- Identify if there are any changes proposed or been made to the delivery of the project.
- Stakeholder engagement summary and significant interactions including meetings with community group and First Nations groups and any key results.
- Updated risk register including any new or emerging risks to the delivery of the Project, and management of those risks.
- Six monthly financial statements and variance report.
