Purpose	This Schedule will improve access to oral health services by supporting Tasmania to deliver dental services to patients eligible for public dental services as per Tasmania’s specified eligibility criteria.

Additional terms	<p><i>Dental Weighted Activity Units</i></p> <p>Throughput under this Schedule will be measured in terms of Dental Weighted Activity Units (DWAUs), calculated using the Australian Dental Association three-digit item codes and a weighting for those items as set out in Schedule B1.</p> <p>Tasmania is required to report to the Commonwealth in the format provided in Schedule B2. Data reported should reflect activity delivered in the specified performance period only and not cumulatively. Tasmania is permitted to use their own reporting mechanisms or existing performance measures within their jurisdiction.</p>															

### *Performance Benchmarks or Milestones*

Performance activity is measured from 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026.

The Parties agree to meet the following performance benchmarks, which will be assessed relative to the 2023 funding activity targets:

- (a) Tasmania will maintain their State/Territory funded DWAU activity (baseline) level, as identified in Table 2 in this Schedule;
- (b) over the life of the Schedule, Tasmania will provide the Commonwealth Funded DWAU activity (above baseline) level as set out in Table 2 below.

Payments will be paid proportional to the achievement against the performance benchmarks outlined in Table 2, on a pro rata basis, i.e. 100 per cent of funding for achieving 100 per cent of the Commonwealth Funded Activity DWAU Target.

If a performance benchmark is not fully met, the unmet performance benchmark and the remaining available funding tied to the unmet benchmark may be added to a subsequent period, subject to Commonwealth Budget Rules.

### *DWAU Activity Rollover*

DWAUs achieved above 100% of the required activity under the 2023-25 Federation Funding Agreement for Public Dental Services for Adults are eligible under this Schedule.

### *Relationship to National Health Reform Agreement*

The National Health Reform Agreement (NHRA) provides that the Commonwealth will not fund a service where the same service, or any part of the same service, is otherwise funded by the Commonwealth. Tasmania will ensure that any claim for funding under the NHRA is not funding services, or any part of a service, provided for under this agreement and will maintain appropriate records.
