Purpose	This Schedule will support delivery of the Tennant Creek Student Boarding Facility (the "Facility") according to the spirit of outcomes established under the Barkly Regional Deal. This includes community consultation to inform Facility design. The Facility will provide comfortable, safe and secure boarding accommodation, with the provision for wrap around services, for 20 male and 20 female secondary students attending Tennant Creek High School. The Facility design will meet stakeholder and community expectations established during the concept design and final design process. This will include, but not be limited to, culturally appropriate design suited to the climate. In its construction and finishes the completed Facility will be fit-for-purpose. This will include, but not be limited to, robust external and internal materials and finishes and appropriate consideration of internal and external acoustic properties.

The Commonwealth will provide an estimated total financial contribution to the States of \$15.9m in respect of this Schedule.

Additional terms

Project Plan and Functional Design Brief needs to include:

- Project management arrangements, including an implementation schedule for the delivery of the project;
- Risk management for both project delivery and for any potential operational risks;
- Governance arrangements including management of approvals or regulatory requirements;
- Stakeholder engagement plan focused on engagement in the design and construction process;
- Functional Design Brief incorporating stakeholder input into the design process, especially that which will ensure the facility will be culturally appropriate and fit-for-purpose;
- Any other information the State considers relevant to enable the Commonwealth to assess the business case or project plan.

This project will ensure that an Indigenous employment target of 8.8% and an Indigenous supplier-use target of 3% is met for the project, and that priority in meeting the targets is given to local Indigenous businesses, organisations and potential employees. Employment data will be provided to the Commonwealth as part of project reporting. Employment and Aboriginal Employment data will be included in tender and contract documentation and provided to the Commonwealth.
