Purpose	<p>This Schedule will support the delivery by Northern Territory of a feasibility study for a copper and critical mineral processing common user facility to enhance Australia's capacity to process critical and strategic materials, and strengthen Australia's sovereign capability and economic resilience.</p> <p>The feasibility study will produce a report on the proposed facilities requirements, feedstock sources, costing estimations, utility usage, the mineral products that would be produced, as well as results from industry, community and First Nations stakeholder engagement.</p>


