Parties	Commonwealth New South Wales																
Duration	This Schedule is expected to expire on 30 December 2026, or on completion of the initiative (whichever is later), including processing of payment and reporting.																
Purpose	This Schedule will support the delivery of \$399,522 in Commonwealth funding for the Maroubra Only About Children Early Education and Care (ECEC) service. The proposal intends to direct funding to the Maroubra ECEC Service to contribute to repairs to restore the service, located at 106 Storey Street, Maroubra, Sydney, NSW. The funding commitment was announced after an emergency National Cabinet meeting on 21 January 2025, following an arson attack and antisemitic graffiti in Sydney, NSW, which affected the Maroubra ECEC service. In accordance with that commitment the Commonwealth and the New South Wales governments agreed to cover any costs to rebuild the Maroubra ECEC service that are not covered by insurance on a 50-50 basis. Total costs identified by the service not covered by insurance is \$799,044.

a)	Total funding of \$399,522 must be directed to the Maroubra ECEC Service as a one-off payment.

b)	The New South Wales State Government will be responsible for the transfer of the \$399,522 funding to the Maroubra ECEC Service and the due diligence and assurance for this transfer. This includes ensuring work is undertaken in accordance with relevant legislation and consistent with clause 20 of the Federation Funding Agreement – Education and Skills. The New South Wales State Government is not liable for any other costs in this agreement.
c)	The Maroubra ECEC Service is currently an approved provider of ECEC and will be responsible for administering the Commonwealth funding as a contribution for restoration of the service. In addition, the Commonwealth is providing a contribution only toward the restoration of the service, and therefore not liable for any additional costs other than those specified in the schedule.
d)	All funding is for the restoration of the service. The Commonwealth or the New South Wales State Government will not own any infrastructure funded through this FFA Schedule.
2.	Announcement and recognition
a)	The Commonwealth will engage with New South Wales to identify potential opportunities for announcement. For the purposes of Clause 21 of the Federation Agreement – Education and Skills, all public materials in relation to the funding must acknowledge the contribution of the Commonwealth.
3.	Reporting and payment on performance milestones The Parties' delegates may meet regularly, to support the governance of this Schedule, including to discuss any shared risk. The New South Wales State Government may also be required to respond to ad-hoc requests for short status/progress updates from the Commonwealth, and is expected to alert the Commonwealth to any material issues as they arise.
4.	Acquittal of funds The New South Wales State Government must maintain records of the acquittal of all funds received from the Commonwealth under this Schedule sufficient to verify that such funds have not been used in a manner contrary to agreed fund usage.
