FEDERATION FUNDING AGREEMENT – INFRASTRUCTURE

Table 1: Formalities and operation of schedule

Parties	Commonwealth Tasmania
Duration	This Schedule is expected to expire on 30 June 2027 or when all project deliverables outlined in this Schedule have been completed and acquitted.
Purpose	This Schedule will support the establishment of the Holocaust Museum and Education Centre of Tasmania as an immersive audio-visual exhibition which includes personal artefacts from the Jewish community, and as a broader education and outreach program.
Estimated financial contributions	The Commonwealth will provide an estimated total financial contribution to the States of \$1,400,000 in respect of this Schedule. The profile for the total financial contribution is presented in Table 1.
Commonwealth Funding Recognition	In addition to the requirements set out in Clause 21 of the Federation Funding Agreement – Infrastructure and the agreed Communications Principles, Tasmania agrees to: a) Recognise the Commonwealth's funding contribution to the project in all publications, promotional and advertising materials, signage, public announcements, media, activities and event invitations in relation to a project as appropriate; b) Hold an official opening of the completed project unless otherwise agreed by the Commonwealth. i. Provide to the Commonwealth options for dates and attendance for the official opening, or any other milestone events or media opportunities that the Recipient chooses to conduct (e.g. sod turn or joint media release), for the project. These options for dates and attendance should be provided at least 30 days prior to secure Commonwealth attendance for each event (e.g. Minister) or potential involvement in any media opportunity to be conducted. ii. Agree the date of official openings or other official public function for the completed project with the Commonwealth.

	iii. Invite a Commonwealth representative to officiate at any official opening or other official public function relating to the project. c) Provide reasonable opportunity for the Commonwealth to contribute to developing communications strategies for projects with a Commonwealth funding contribution. d) Provide the Commonwealth with equal access to products that they obtain for use in the development of promotional material, including but not limited to project data, footage and images. e) Where relevant, as discussed between officials, ensure all signage and any online or printed materials related to the Holocaust Museum and Education Centre of Tasmania project meet the requirements of the Building Australia Signage and Brand Guidelines, available at https://investment.infrastructure.gov.au/resources-funding/recipients/signage-guidelines. f) Signage, relevant websites, and all publications and promotional material including the Commonwealth and Tasmanian Government logos, and the words "The Holocaust Museum and Education Centre of Tasmania is funded by the Tasmanian and Australian Governments" (or similar wording as otherwise agreed between the Commonwealth and Tasmania). g) Acknowledge the Commonwealth in any branding or signage that is displayed to mark the official opening or other official public functions for activities relating to the project.
Program Reporting	For the purpose of monitoring and assessing performance, Tasmania will report to the Commonwealth on project progress as set out in the performance milestones agreed in this schedule. Tasmania will liaise with any third-party proponent and provide relevant information on the development and progress of the funded project to the Commonwealth on request. Tasmania will support the Commonwealth to respond to ad-hoc queries in relation to the project.
Additional terms	In addition to its other responsibilities, where possible, Tasmania agrees to: a) Provide opportunities for local Tasmanian businesses and employees to be involved in the project. b) Provide opportunities for Tasmanian Aboriginal businesses and employees to be involved in the project.

Scope of Works	The Holocaust Museum and Education Centre of Tasmania will include the design, construction and fit-out of exhibition, education and visitor spaces. The exhibition will include permanent and temporary interpretive graphics, object-based displays, interactive audio-visual displays, ambient lighting, and visitor seating.

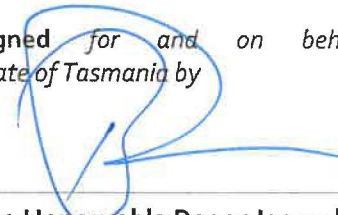
